# Garden Savings Federal Credit Union Scholarship Application 2025



#### The Award

Garden Savings Federal Credit Union's Scholarships are four separate \$500 book scholarships that will be awarded directly to our top four scoring applicants. These funds can be used toward tuitions, book purchases, or just to get a head start on a busy college career.

#### Eligibility

The applicant must be a member in good standing of Garden Savings Federal Credit Union as of 12/31/2024 and must be enrolled as a high school senior at the time of the application. Scholarship funds may be used as the student sees fit.

# **Application Process**

Eligible members must complete this scholarship application in its entirety and return it to Garden Savings by the March 31, 2025 deadline. A student may submit only one application. The application must be completed and signed by the student and parent/guardian and authorized by an executive management-level official of the credit union (see page 2).

The signed and completed application must be submitted with the following:

- An official high school transcript that includes a cumulative GPA of completed marking periods as of date of submission. GPA must be NON-WEIGHTED on a 4.0 scale.
- The completed Teacher Reference portion of the application (see page 4). It must be completed and signed by one of the applicant's teachers.

The application (page 2 and 3 of this form), transcript, and Teacher Reference (page 4) must be returned to the credit union by the application deadline: March 31, 2025. If any portion of the application is incomplete or not included, the applicant will be disqualified.

#### **Selection Process**

Judging is based on academic performance, extracurricular activities, community service/ involvement, references, and leadership roles. Students will be notified of the scholarship winners by June 1, 2025.
